2. What sources and data do we use?

Master data	If provided by you, for example: title, name, institution, position, postal address, visitor address, telephone, fax, email address, website, customer number, order and delivery details
Data protection declarations	Declarations of consent, declarations of revocation, declarations of objection, declarations regarding the right to information, correction, deletion, restriction of processing, declarations regarding data portability
Information	Information/publications requested by you, specialist information requested by you

3. What do we process your data for (purpose of processing) and on what legal basis?

We would like to point out that we collect, store, process and use personal data for the purpose of initiating, establishing and processing contractual and delivery relationships, including delivery, payment and any warranty. The data collected from you is necessary for the conclusion and processing of a contract. You are not obliged to provide the data; however, without this data we cannot conclude a contract with you (legal basis: Art. 6 (1) (b) GDPR).

Furthermore we collect, store, process and use the data for the purpose of maintaining customer and business relationships, marketing and advertising our products and services. Our legitimate interest in processing your data in this regard arises from our desire to promote and sell our products and services (legal basis: Art. 6 (1) (f) GDPR).

Additionally we process data that we receive from credit agencies for the purpose of credit checks on our customers, suppliers and business partners. Our legitimate interest in this respect arises from our interest in receiving the contractually owed consideration for our services (legal basis: Art. 6 (1) (f) GDPR).

With regard to the processing of your data for the duration of statutory retention periods under commercial and tax law, processing is carried out on the basis of Art. 6 (1) © GDPR.

We also process your data based on your explicit consent. The purpose and nature of the processing are determined by your declaration of consent, which you may revoke at any time.

4. How long is the data stored?

The data is stored for the duration of the business relationship with the customer and until the expiration of warranty periods and statutory retention periods. If consent has been given, the data will be stored until you revoke your consent or the purpose for storing the data no longer applies. If the data subject has consented to further use of the data, the data will not be deleted.

5. Is data passed on? (categories of recipients)

Data is not passed on to third parties, with exception of

✗	Transfer to third parties for the processing of contractual and delivery relationships, e.g. banks, transport/shipping companies
✗	Service providers within the scope of order processing
✗	Disclosure to third parties due to legal obligations, as well as commercial and tax law obligations (e.g. tax advisors, tax office, authorities, etc.)

Data will only be transferred to a third country outside the European Union if this data transfer is necessary for the fulfilment of a contract between you and us and only if the specific requirements of Art. 44 ff. GDPR are met.

6. What data protection rights do you have?

Every data subject has the right to information under Article 15 GDPR, the right to rectification under Article 16 GDPR, the right to erasure under Article 17 GDPR, the right to restriction of processing under Article 18 GDPR, the right to data portability under Art. 20 GDPR, and the right to object under Art. 21 GDPR. To exercise the aforementioned rights, you can contact the office mentioned in section 1. In addition, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the data protection supervisory authority (Art. 77 GDPR). 7. In addition, you have the right to withdraw any given consent, as explained in more detail below

Right to revoke my declaration of consent

If the underlying data processing is based on consent, this consent is voluntary and can be revoked at any time for the future.
